Count the Days

- For Germany, France Great Britain, and Russia, the war began on August 3, 1914
- For the United States, the war began on April 5, 1917
- ▶ The war ended for Russia on March 3, 1917
- The war ended for Great Britain, France, Germany, and the Unites States on Nov. 11, 1918
- How many days were each of the nations at war?

Deaths per day

If the following suffered these losses,

Germany lost 2,050,897

France lost 1,397,800

Great Britain lost 885,138

Russia lost 1,811,000

United States lost 116,708
